



THE MAIN DIRECTIONS OF ORGANIZING MILITARY-PATRIOTIC EDUCATION

Abstract: *Like all socio-political activities, there is a certain system and formal style in military-patriotic work. It includes specific tasks, content of forms and methods, tools, as well as state and public enterprises, organizations and institutions performing specific tasks. This system, form, first of all, has a complex nature, that is, the formation of a sense of patriotism is the task of all educational institutions. Secondly, it is continuous, because it is in effect in all periods of a person's life. Thirdly, it is a complete form because it relies on all types of education and the unity of the army and the people.*
