NEW REFORMS IN THE SCHOOL AND PRESCHOOL SYSTEM

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Annotation: The main and most fundamental link in continuous education is the educational system. Up until the age of 6-7 years, preschool education is provided by the family, kindergarten, and other educational institutions. Experts' scientific judgments state that a person learns 70% of all the knowledge and information he will ever acquire at the age of five. As a result, kindergarten education is crucial in ensuring that kids grow up to be healthy, intelligent adults. This article provides feedback and insights into new reforms in the school and preschool education system.

It is known that alternate, flexible models for preparing kids for school were not sufficiently established prior to the founding of the Ministry of Preschool Education, and current programs were not integrated into the system. As in industrialized nations, there were no special governmental educational initiatives for children's social, personal, emotional, language, math, physical, and creative growth or environmental awareness. Most of the pedagogical personnel operating in public preschool institutions had secondary special education, which made it impossible to prepare children at the level of demand for school education.

Following the example of the decree of the president of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated May 8, 2019 "on approval of the concept of development of the preschool education system until 2030", this concept covers the priorities and stages of the process, ensuring equal use of quality preschool education by children, the development of preschool services, in a word, the development of preschool education system.

The appropriate maturity of the current youth, which will determine the future of our homeland, is linked to the ongoing development of education at the contemporary level. The most urgent mission that we have set for ourselves is to increase the coverage of children with preschool education and further improve the utilization of preschool services in order to provide favorable conditions for their full-fledged life activities and to actively engage in social life.

Large-scale work has also been carried out in the Okhdarya District Preschool Department on healthy and comprehensively mature upbringing of the growing generation, the introduction of effective forms and methods of education and education in the educational process, the organization of an effective system of

preschool education. There are 35 neighborhood citizens assemblies in oqdarya district, with 13,608 children of preschool age aged 3-7.

The teaching of a foreign language in the classroom, together with the development of a teacher-educator base with excellent qualifications and subject-specific expertise, is one of the criteria for schools. It was mentioned that the creation of such specialized schools serves to instill a sense of patriotism in young people. After studying the potential and possibility of the areas, the problem of vocational assistance for pupils in grades 8-9 was also discussed at the meeting. This opens the door to new opportunities for students to master the craft at a later stage of Education. Now graduates of secondary schools can be prepared for about 50 professions. To do this, on the basis of vocational colleges and secondary schools, modern equipped educational production centers are planned. Also, some professional colleges are attached to enterprises and organizations to the relevant ministries and departments.

In conclusion, since the first years of independence, the development of the education system in our country has been raised to the level of state policy, and it is ensured that our children acquire modern knowledge and skills in conditions corresponding to world standards, and grow up to be physically and spiritually mature people. Great work is being done to provide them, to realize their abilities and talents, to realize their intellectual potential, to perfect the feelings of loyalty and devotion to the motherland in the hearts of our youth.

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
