Constant excessive praise, comparisons with the team, the release of assertiveness-all this provokes the appearance of courageous, selfish qualities in the reader. When organizing incentives, along with the success of the student, it is necessary to take into account his place in the team, moral image, as well as collective opinion about the attitude to work, team tasks, and the team itself.
