Every maturing young generation of Uzbekistan is obliged to be no less than anyone, a mature educated scientist who can fully meet the level of World educational standards, and we must enter into this with our enthusiasm. To date, the demand and interest in learning foreign languages, especially English, has increased so much that children of kindergarten age are trying to learn English from adult professionals. This is a positive situation, of course, because the study of the language provides the basis for the opening of doors in the interests of the individual, along with the study of the culture, history and customs of the countries that speak that language. As noted, within the framework of the implementation of the law of the Republic of Uzbekistan "on education" and the National Training Program, a comprehensive system of training in foreign languages was created in our country, that is, a more focused system on the formation of a harmoniously matured educated, modern-minded young generation and the world community of the Republic.

LITERATURE ANALYSIS AND RESULTS

The use of modern technologics in teaching a foreign language can contribute to an increase in efficiency. DISCUSSION AND RESULTS

During the years of independence, more than 51.7 thousand foreign language teachers were prepared multimedia textbooks on English, German and French for grades 5-9 of general educational schools, and electronic resources for Learning English in primary classes were prepared. More than 5-thousand lingafon cabinets were equipped in general educational schools, vocational colleges and academic lyceums. At the same time, foreign languages were equipped. At the same time, the analysis of the current system of organizing the study of foreign languages shows that educational standards do not fully comply with the requirements of curricula and textbooks, in particular, with regard to the use of advanced information and media technologies. Education is mainly conducted in traditional styles. The organization of continuous learning of foreign languages at all stages of the educational system also requires further improvement of teachers 'skills and provision of modern educational and methodological materials. Through the introduction of advanced teaching methods using modern pedagogical and information and communication technologies, the education of the growing young generation to foreign languages is a radical improvement of the system of training specialists who can speak these languages freely, and on the basis of this, their achievements of world civilization and their achievements of world civilization and their widespread use of World Information Resources, since the 2013/2014 academic year in order to create conditions and opportunities for them to develop international cooperation and communication, the study of foreign languages in all regions of the Republic, mainly English, begins with the acquisition of the alphabet, reading and grammar from the first grades of General Educational Schools in the form of play-style lessons and oral lessons. Every year in our country, several areas of science are selected and developed with special attention. This year, physics and foreign languages were established as such priority areas. Uzbekistan's policy of openness, development of Tourism, active entry into the world market with the shahdam step, expansion of cooperation in all areas create a great need for the study of foreign languages. Currently, there are 25 higher education in our country. Teaching of foreign languages has now been introduced in 25 higher education institutions in our country. In 2016, there were only 7. The number of graduate students with international language certification has increased 10-fold in the last 3 years. This year, 350 students from the prestigious foreign countries through the hope of El yurt Foundation stependas were allocated to study at universities. This is 5 times more than in previous years. In the educational system, more than 2 thousand foreign language teacher positions remain vacancies. It is necessary to improve the quality of teaching a foreign language in 1 million 400 schools. 4% of specialist teachers in this field have a national and international language certificate. 49% of teachers in schools did not pass the test. In a word, in our state, through the chain of "kindergarten-school-Higher Education-Enterprise, manuals are being

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developed that are adapted to the study of the language in a way that is appropriate for all segments of the population, audio-video and intensive." Along with Tashkent State Institute of world languages and Oriental Languages and universities of Oriental Studies, Samarkand Institute of foreign languages, one university in each region was designated as a base institution for foreign languages. In addition, teachers who receive high scores are reimbursed for the costs of taking tests to obtain an international certificate. Starting next year, Foreign Language teachers who are being hired will be required to have a national and international certificate. In the next 3 years, 53,000 Foreign Language teachers will be required to have a national and international certificate. From the new school year, it was confirmed that the number of admission quotas for foreign languages will be increased by 2 times to 16 thousand, and the state grant will be increased by 3 times. At the same time, from next year, the requirement for obtaining a certificate in a foreign language is introduced for those entering graduate and doctoral studies. The use of foreign textbooks and manuals in natural and technical sciences was established. "The use of El guides has been established. Through the hope of El yurt Foundation, 20 places are allocated per year for training in foreign doctoral studies. Further strengthening cooperation with foreign organizations such as the British Council, the Gyoti Institute, the French alliance, Koika, Jaika, the Confucius Institute, the expansion of the non-governmental training center, was an important task. The Cabinet of Ministers will decide in order to effectively implement organizational measures to popularize foreign language learning in the Republic of Uzbekistan in accordance with the decree of the president of the Republic of Uzbekistan "on measures to bring foreign language learning to a qualitatively new level in the Republic of Uzbekistan", PQ-5117 of May 19, 2021. Coordinates the activities of state bodies and organizations, local executive authorities and state educational institutions to popularize the teaching of foreign languages. Coordinates foreign domestic activities. Establishes relations with foreign domestic partners and organizes their financial, organizational and methodological support to attract the popularization of the study of foreign languages in the country.
