In Milan "La - A dance school was opened at the "Skala" theater. By Enrico Cecchetti this school became more alive. Leading Russian ballet from E. Checketti A. Pavlova, V. Nijinsky, T. Krasavina were educated. In 1928, a ballet school was established under the Opera Theater of Rome.In 1960, "National Academy of Dance" by Ye.Vorosenko began to be managed. There are teams for individual plays started their activities. Nervida International Ballet Festival, "Florence "Musical May" festival, "Contemporary Music" festival in Venice, Spoleta and Verona festivals were held. French dance foundation of a new stage art genre - "Comedy-Ballet" at the Academy was put The founder of the comedy-ballet is Jean Baptiste, a famous playwright Moliere (1622-1673). J.B. Molière was not only a great playwright, but also a skilled actor and dancer in dramatic works.
