PROSPECTS OF USING ELECTRONIC DICTIONARIES IN LEARNING FOREIGN LANGUAGES

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Abstract: In this article, the students' need for using electronic dictionaries in the process of learning foreign languages and their effectiveness in the educational process are presented.

- development and implementation of information and communication technologies, software projects in the popularization of learning foreign languages;

– creating video clips, games, entertainment programs, films and other educational content for the thorough mastery of foreign languages and the formation of basic language skills;

– attraction of highly qualified specialists, including local and foreign experts, etc. on the basis of civil-legal contracts;

In order to further improve the teaching of foreign languages, special attention is paid to the use of advanced technologies in the educational process and, in

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particular, in the lessons, and on this basis, to increase the efficiency. This article deals with the use of electronic dictionaries in the educational process and its effectiveness in teaching foreign languages.
