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



One of the reasons for this was the devaluation of high ideas in Western society, the chaos of the human psyche, which led a tireless, meaningless life. The modern style includes romanticism, sensuality, a delicate nature and a solid, solid linear structural foundation from Western literature. Oriental Art is characterized by rhythmic expression, rich and elegant embroidery, Oriental elegance.

The modern style of the late 19th – early 20th centuries, embodied in European culture, was embodied in the reader's imagination as the continuation of ancient world civilization, Volume 1, Number 10, 124, the literary process became an integral part of universal cultural development. In the late 19th-early 20th centuries, ideas of modernism began to enter Russian literature. V.Bryusov, N.Gumilyov, A.Akhmatova, M.The activity of svetaeva is a vivid evidence of this. Only A.Platonov's novels" Kotlovan"," Chevengur", M.Bulgakov's "defender of the arrow", "Master and Margarita", B.Pasternak's "Doctor Zhivago", V.Nabokov, I.The bunins created literature in harmony with the modern West. The creativity of writers occupies a worthy place on the stage of world literature of the 20th century.



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
